

Instructions for Posting Emergency Response Signage

Attention Class A/B Operators:

By law you must post emergency response signage at your UST site to help someone respond to a spill, fire or release. Use this fill-in-the-blank template to meet the requirement.

This emergency response signage must:

- **Instruct on what to do** in case of an emergency.
- **Be posted in prominent areas** easily visible to individuals who dispense or deliver regulated substances (like gasoline and diesel). This means one by the dispenser and one by the fill area if different.
- **Identify the address** of the UST location and any emergency contact numbers.
- **Identify the location** of fire extinguishers and any emergency shut-off devices at the facility.

What to do now?

1. **Download and print this 3 page document in color.**
2. **Fill in the blanks on the signage.**
3. **Laminate signage.**
4. **Post signage by dispenser and fill area.**
5. **Make sure your Class C operators know about the signage.**
